They may take part in the discussion only when the Council invites them to do so. Each speaker should receive recognition from the presiding officer, give his or her name and address, the organization he or she represents, and state his or her opinions briefly and concisely. There will be a limit set on the time any individual may consume in debate.

For your convenience, you may fill out the bottom of this page prior to the meeting and present it to the City Clerk / Treasurer. Or, you may request to be recognized during the item, "Public Comment" and state the same information. Filling out the information prior to the meeting will facilitate the process.
