CHAPTER 260

PROHIBITING THE DELIVERY OR SETTING OFF OF FIRECRACKERS AND FIREWORKS

[History: Ord 302]

260.01 No person shall fire, explode or set off any squib, firecracker or other firework or explosive device containing gunpowder or other combustible or explosive matter within the City of Richland Center, except as hereinafter provided.

260.02 No person, firm or corporation shall sell, exchange, furnish or give away any squib, firecracker or other thing containing gunpowder or other combustible or explosive matter within the City of Richland Center, except to public authorities or private persons who have been granted a permit to possess and display fireworks by the Mayor or Common Council. Such fireworks may be used and displayed by a permitholder only in open fields, public parks, private parks, or on rivers, lakes or ponds. This provision shall not be deemed to prohibit the transfer of bulk smokeless powder intended for firearm cartridge reloading purposes.

260.03 PENALTY. Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit to the City of Richland Center not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00, together with the costs of prosecution and any applicable penalty assessment, and if such forfeiture, costs and assessment are not paid, shall be imprisoned in the Richland County Jail until such forfeiture, costs and assessment are paid, but not to exceed ninety (90) days.
