ORDINANCE 2020-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 303.065 LIMITING THE NUMBER OF DOGS PERMITTED ON A PREMISES WITHIN THE CITY AND REPEALING SECTION 303.07 PROVIDING FOR KENNEL LICENSES IN THE CITY

The Common Council of the City of Richland Center, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section 303.065 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

303.065 LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF DOGS PER PREMISES. The occupant or occupants of any premises within the City of Richland Center shall not keep, possess or maintain on the premises more than two (2) dogs. Said two-dog limitation is intended to impose an aggregate limit on the number of permitted dogs per premises, regardless of the number of persons occupying the premises. For purposes of this subsection, a premises is defined as any dwelling unit, community living arrangement, lot in a commercial use or in an industrial use, as those terms are defined in Chapter 479 of the Code of Ordinances. A multi-unit housing complex is permitted to two dogs per domiciliary unit.

SECTION 2:

Section 303.07 of the Code of Ordinances providing for kennel licenses in the City is repealed.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
