## **CHAPTER 333**

## REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF RAW AND PASTEURIZED MILK, CREAM AND SKIM-MILK IN THE CITY OF RICHLAND CENTER, WISCONSIN

[History Ord 321]

- **333.01** The word "dairy" whenever used in this chapter shall mean any person, co-partnership, or corporation selling or distributing raw or pasteurized milk, cream or skim-milk for direct human consumption in the City of Richland Center.
- **333.02** No dairy shall operate, sell or distribute milk, cream or skim-milk in the City of Richland Center without first obtaining a license therefor from the said City, to be issued by the City Clerk upon payment of a fee for each license of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per annum.
- **333.03** The City Health Officer shall be charged with the enforcement of this chapter and the several provisions thereof, and shall make a written report to the City Council at least once a month. For his services rendered in such enforcement, he shall be paid the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month, which said sum is hereby appropriated for such purpose, payable first out of the moneys received for the licenses hereinabove provided, next out of all forfeitures collected pursuant to the provisions hereof, and lastly out of the general funds.
