

1) Krouskop Park: 37.5 acres

Playground equipment, areas for picnicking, swimming pool, Ice rink with warming house, 2 lighted baseball/softball diamonds, basketball court, 2 lighted tennis courts, 2 lighted pickleball courts, 2 sand volleyball courts, 8 shelters, restrooms, walking & snowshoe trails, groomed cross country ski trails along the river, and access to fishing and canoeing/kayaking on the Pine River. Canoe/Kayak Port #3. Five RV camping sites & NEW Veteran's Memorial Pavilion!

2) Community/Senior Center

Located at Krouskop Park. An all-purpose facility that can be rented for all activities. Activities include: auctions, rummage sales, receptions, civic events, public meetings and much more.

3) North Park: 12.5 acres

Two lighted baseball/softball diamonds, two youth baseball fields, several soccer fields, a picnic shelter along with a double shelter for concessions, walking & snowshoe trails, groomed cross country ski trails, groomed areas to skate ski and open space for picnicking.

4) North Lake Park: 3.5 acres

Stocked pond with a variety of pan fish, gazebos, a shelter for rentals and open space for picnicking.

5) Old Mill Pond Park & Mill Pond Community Gardens The site of the original Community Center, now has a shelter, all accessible fishing pier/canoe/kayak port, walking & snowshoe trails, groomed cross country ski trails, and open space for picnicking. Canoe/Kayak Port #4. Raised garden beds available for rent, includes water access. Five RV camping sites.

6) Westside Park: 3 acres

Playground equipment, gardens, a gazebo and scenic picnic areas near a historic wood walking bridge giving access to trails and downtown.

7) Strickland Park: 3 acres

Playground equipment, picnicking and access to Minor Hill hiking trails.

8) Minor Hill Trails Park: 50 acres

A hiking/snowshoeing trail that has 5 scenic overlooks to the City of Richland Center. Trail is complete with signs and areas for picnicking.

9) City Arboretum: 4 acres

Plantings of over 120 different species of trees and shrubs, along the bike trail and river trails.

10) Wedgewood North/South: 30 acres

Two parks that include parking, picnic tables, benches and walking/snowshoe trails along the river. South has a restroom and Canoe/Kayak Port #5.

11) North Side Community Garden: spaces available to rent. No water access here, you must bring your own.

12) Lions Park:

Chellevold shelter, sand volleyball court, open area for picnicking, restroom, and river access from Canoe/Kayak Port #2, two RV camping sites, and Pine River Raceway.

13) Woodman Happy Tails Dog Park: 2 acres on Industrial Drive. Small & Large dog areas, agility fun, seating, water access. Please Scoop Your Poop!

14) Ocooch Mountain Trails- Peebles Drive trailhead Mountain Bike/Hike trails as well as snowshoe/ski trails. Parking available in the south end of Armory lot.

15) City Canoe/Kayak Ports & Walking/Snowshoe/Ski Trails Six updated canoe/kayak ports along the scenic Pine River with walking trails developed by two Eagle Scouts.
