

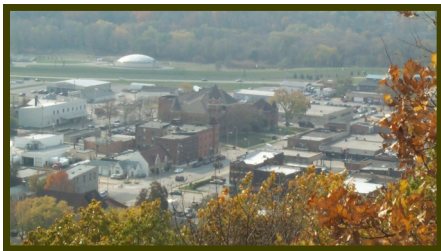
The 50 acre Miner Hill Bluff overlooks the City of Richland Center from its east side.

The bluff features several trails that take hikers to five scenic overlooks, wooded areas, open meadows, and to an old quarry site.

There are trail heads on Court Street, Pearl Street, and Ithaca Road/N, all with limited parking.

All trail overlooks are railed and the trail itself is complete with trail signs and detailed informational maps.

Several improvements were made to this park in recent years, including the addition of picnicking facilities, improved fencing, and the opening up of new areas for scenic overlooks.

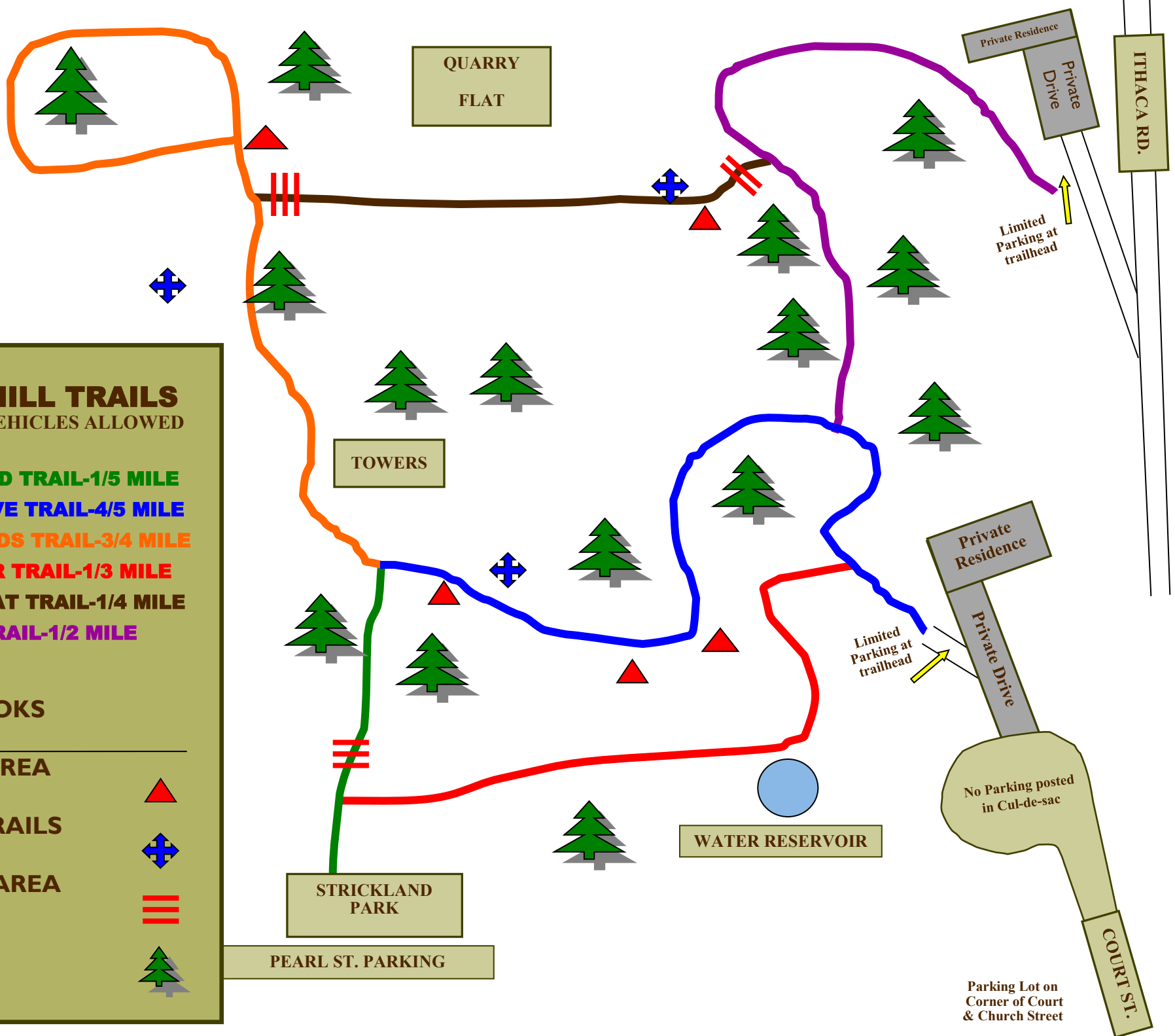
