

## Household Recyclables (separated recycling only) paper, cardboard, newspapers, magazines; glass bottles and jars; tin cans; aluminum cans & foil; plastic 1-7 Residential Yard Wate (leave outside landfill gate in compost area) brush, tree limbs, leaves, grass clippings, garden organic waste Scrap Metal (metal free of all other materials i.e. wood, plastic, cardboard)

Note: incandescent bulbs, latex or acrylic paint and small household batteries may be disposed of in household garbage. See the backside of this sheet for information on where to dispose of LED, fluorescent, and vapor bulbs, oil-based paint, and larger batteries.

<ul> <li>Coffee machines, vacuums, shampooers, heaters (small), room fans, ceiling fans, small kitchen appliances, etc.</li> </ul>		
Microwaves, Televisions, Copy Machines	\$25 per item	
Construction Materials (all items and materials accruing from alteration, repair, or construction of a structure)	\$15 min or \$115/ton	
Clean Concrete (no rebar)	\$20/ton

## ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

**Batteries:** The Richland Center Landfill accepts household batteries. For larger batteries check with auto part stores or repair shops.

**Cell phones:** check with cell phone stores; also accepted at the Richland County Electronics & Tire Collection event

**Electronics**: Goodwill (649-2110) is a drop-off point for computers, laptops, printers, speakers, scanners, shredders, record players, VCRs, DVD players, gaming systems, cameras, camcorders; also accepted at the Richland County Electronics & Tire Collection event

**Flags:** Walsh's Ace Hardware (647-8925) & the American Legion (647-3714) will accept American flags to be respectfully disposed

**Ink Cartridges:** small home printer ink cartridges may be put in the collection drop box located in the Electronics Department at Wal-Mart (647-7141)

Light Bulbs (LED, fluorescent, vapor, etc.): see Walsh's Ace Hardware (647-8925) (fee based on bulb type); accepted at the Richland County Electronics & Tire Collection event (fee based on bulb type)

**Medications:** drop-off boxes may be found at the city municipal building and The Richland Hospital

**Oil Based Paint:** accepted at the Richland County Electronics & Tire Collection event

**Medical Sharps:** collection box located at The Richland Hospital

**Oil Filters & Used Oil:** check with auto part stores or repair shops; collection tank for used oil (free of additives) at no charge located at Richland County Highway Shop (23630 County Highway AA)

Plastic Bags: drop box may be found at Wal-Mart

**Tires:** seek auto shops or salvage yards for disposal; also accepted at the Richland County Electronics & Tire Collection event

Curbside pickup of electronics, appliances, furniture, and tires is available for **city** residents. Call 608-3466 for fees and scheduling.
