

Minutes of the public works committee

City municipal building

Tuesday, April 12th, 2022

1. Roll call, Alderman Sue Fruit, Alderman Karin Tepley, street superintendent Terry Nelson, city Administrator Ashley Oliphant were present. Meeting was properly noticed.

2. Motion to waive reading of minutes by Sue Fruit. 2nd by Karin Tepley. motion carried.

3. Superintendents report. Terry Nelson reported that the large item pickup had taken place on April 2nd. There were a few complaints that items were not picked up. Terry called town and country sanitation and they did pick up the remaining residents items except for the commercial properties within city limits. These properties are not under the city garbage contract.

Terry also reported that the 3/4 ton pick up had been ordered, but is unsure of a delivery date.

Terry and Ashley have both had contact with Josh Elder from the Richland county highway dept. regarding billing for two way radios. Josh said there will no longer be a charge for the use of the radio tower.

4. Discussion and possible action regarding billing issue with Town and Country Sanitation. Karin Tepley was in contact with TCS along with Shaun Walsh from the city clerks office. the billing issue has been resolved, but the past two years of overbilling has not. A meeting will be set up with the owner of TCS to resolve the issue.

5. Discussion and possible action on developing a list of customers requesting a different size garbage and/ or recycling container from TCS.

TCS will change out garbage totes only. this will be on customers request only. the customer will need to contact TCS for the change in tote size and there will be a \$ 20.00 charge to the customer for each time a change is requested.

Motion by Sue Fruit to have TCS change garbage tote sizes for customers upon their request with the customer paying the \$ 20.00 charge. 2nd by Karin Tepley. Motion carried.

6. Discussion and possible action on approving bid for pull behind mower for the street dept.

Three bids were received. Simpson Tractor was low bid at \$21,443.00. Carl F. Statz was 2nd at \$21,750.00. The Homesteaders Store was 3rd at \$23,732.25. Motion by Sue Fruit to accept bid from Simpson Tractor for the price of \$21,443.00. 2nd by Karin Tepley. Motion carried. Terry will check on the availability.

7. Discussion and possible action on approving marking paint for the street dept.

Baily Paint was the only bid. with the bid of \$ 6,812.60. Motion by Karin Tepley to accept bid from Baily Paint . 2nd by Sue Fruit. Motion carried.
