HEARING FOR PROPERTY OWNERS WHO RECEIVED HAZARD TREE CUT LETTERS

Letter sent to owners at 236 S Sheldon St. regarding tree near sidewalk and lines. The tree is mostly dead and is dropping limbs. A Certified Letter was received by property owners and they also responded to an email informing them of the moved Tree Board Meeting date. Owners not present.

CITY FORESTER UPDATE

- 1. Tree Cutting Update City trees on this year's tree cut list have all been cut. Stumps have been ground and cleaned up. Soil will be brought to fill remaining holes.
- 2. Tree Planting Update- Trees that were ordered have arrived, but we will need to order a few more as replacements for cut boulevard trees. At least 14 city trees will be planted. Two were already planted during Arbor Day event.
- 3. Tree City USA Update The Tree City application was approved, making this our 26th year as a Tree City.
- 4. Upcoming Classes and Trainings Barr-Hamblin has applied for the CTMI training for Urban Forester through the DNR. It is a six day training spread out through year.
- 5. Arbor Day/Earth Day Event Even was held at the Brewer Library in coordination with Rachel Wilson. There was a storytime with Brian Wahl, DNR urban forester. He also had a game prepared to play with the kids. The group planted two Lilacs in the boulevard at the library. Brian did a tree planting demonstration. I distributed free trees provided by the DNR. The remaining trees went to the community center during the Senior Expo. We distributed 75 tree seedlings. Barr-Hamblin plans to improve advertising next year. This event fulfills requirements for Tree City USA certification.
